

## Darcy's Supply Request 2009-2010

### Personal supplies: (marked with your child's name)

Tennis shoes (these stay at school for boot days and PE), lunch box, backpack, water bottle, a cloth napkin to be used as a placemat (to be kept in your child's lunchbox and washed as needed), 4 wide ruled black marble **composition books** (not spiral kind), 1 tea mug for literary/author's tea, index card box, 3 **plastic folders** with brads inside--1 yellow, 1 red, 1 blue (**for children new to the classroom only**)

### Supplies shared:

These items will be used and stored communally so please don't put a name on them. You don't need to send in storage boxes for pencils, scissors, etc.

- 24 count Crayola colored pencils
- 24 yellow #2 pencils (Ticonderoga sharpen the best....no mechanical pencils please)
- 2 **ultra fine black** Sharpies
- 1 pack white lined index cards
- 3 pack of white **Magic Rub** erasers
- 1 box of assorted sized Band-aids
- 2 reams of white **recycled** copy paper
- 1 large box of tissues

#### First grade only:

- Cloth placemat (gently used is okay)
- 1 refill bottle of Clorox **Green Works** spray
- package of Vis-à-vis markers

#### Second grade only:

- 1 pack of white washcloths/bar cloths
- 1 handheld good quality pencil sharpener (not battery operated)
- Pack of small sponges for cleaning

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> grade only:

- two 3-ring binders (2" white)
- pack of plastic Post it note flags
- 1 ream of pastel colored **recycled** copy paper
