



VOLUNTEERISM AT MONTESSORI PEAKS ACADEMY

Parents are encouraged to become involved in the school at all levels. Each family is asked to contribute 50 volunteer hours, 25 for single parent families; per academic year. This equates to approximately 5 hours per month. Many opportunities are available to volunteer. Check with your student's lead teacher for classroom volunteer needs. Listed below are the committees MPA offers.

- **Fundraising Committee**

- **Community Relations**

This committee helps coordinate and schedule volunteer activities; tally volunteers hours and acts as the liaison between board committees, PTA and administration.
