Judy Faulder Class Supply List 2010 – 2011

**** Please Note** In an effort to save resources second and third graders have supplies in their drawer from last year that can be used this year (scissors, pencil box, Grammar notebook, 3x5 card holder). So please do not shop for extra.

Marked with your child's name:

- Tennis shoes (These stay at school for PE)
 - 1 Small lunch box
 - 1 Small back pack that fits your child
 - 1 Water bottle
 - One small plastic pencil box to hold the following
 - 24 **Crayola** colored pencils
 - 1 pair of **Fiskars** scissors pointed tips - can cut fabric well
- 3 Composition books (2 for writers' notebook, 1 for grammar)
- 3 folders **WITH BRADS** plastic is preferred
Blue –Language, Red – Math, Green /Yellow – Spelling)
2nd and 3rd graders may have these at school from last year.
- 1 folder with bottom pockets for work in progress. No side pockets
- 1 3X5 card holder (box or folder)
- 1 pack of white 3x5 cards with lines

Supplies that are shared as a class
